# **LE GRAND AIR**

- 30° machine/hand wash
- Delicates/easy care setting
- No fabric softeners

- No tumble drying
- Mild detergent without bleach
- Wash all of the covers at the same time

### **DRYING**

After washing, remove the fabric immediately from the machine, stretch the fabric to the edges, and let it dry flat.

#### **STAINS**

Treat the stain instead of washing the whole piece of fabric as superfluous washes will wear out the fabric unnecessarily. Use the recommended stain removing agent..

Tip: First try testing a spot that isn't visible to avoid unintentionally tinting the fabric.

#### **IRONING**

Ironing can give the fabric a smoother appearance. If you choose to iron the fabric, it is important to follow the recommendation on your iron for this type of fabric.

Tip: Iron at a maximum of 150° C (300° F) using the equivalent cotton/linen setting. Iron while the fabric is moist, remoisten the fabric if necessary.

# **PUTTING ON YOUR COVER**

First check that the fabric still has 15-20% of its moisture remaining. Stretch the fabric before putting it back on to the sofa. After the sofa is covered, stretch the bottom edge of the fabric around the frame.

## **UV-LIGHT**

As the fabric is not treated with chemicals, it should not be exposed to direct sunlight. If you want to protect the fabric against stains and UV-radiation, we recommend that you treat the fabric with a textile protector.

Tip: After washing you should reapply the textile protector to the fabric.

## **GENERAL CARE**

To maintain the quality, be sure to regularly vacuum the sofa, fluff the seat and back cushions, and change the places of the pillows so that they are worn evenly through use. Periodically straighten the fabric over the frame so that the seams line up correctly as they may shift during use.
